

MUSIC LICENCE FORM - TARIFF 21 – RECREATIONAL FACILITIES operated by a municipality, school, college, university, agricultural society or similar community organizations

- Grants you permission to perform in public musical works during recreational activities that would otherwise be subject to the following tariffs:
 - Sports events incl. minor hockey, figure and roller skating, amateur rodeos etc. (tariff 9)
 - Receptions, conventions, assemblies or fashion shows (tariff 8)
 - Skating rinks (tariff 7)
 - Exhibition and fairs (tariff (5A))
 - Fitness activities and dance instruction(tariff 19)
 - Circuses, fireworks displays, ice or sound & light shows and similar events (tariff 11A)
- Deadline for SOCAN to receive forms and payments is January 31st of the year for which a licence is granted, except for first time reports

The legal terms that govern your licence include those set out herein as well as those found in the approved tariff including the General Provisions, as approved by the Copyright Board of Canada for each year (collectively, the “*tariff*”). If you have any questions regarding the terms, please [contact us](#).

1. In this form, *you*, *your* and *licensee* means the person or company applying for a licence or filing an annual report. *We*, *our*, *us* and *SOCAN* means the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada. *Works* means any or all of the musical works in SOCAN’s repertoire.
2. A copy of any SOCAN tariff may be obtained by emailing licence@socan.ca or calling 1.866.944.6223.
3. If you are applying for a licence, SOCAN will process your application within 30 days of receipt and contact you in the event that your application is not approved. If you already have a licence under this tariff, this is your annual report.
4. If the tariff for a year has not been approved by January 1st of that year, the last approved tariff will govern until the new tariff is approved, at which time the licence fees will be adjusted to reflect the approved tariff for the year.
5. This licence will renew automatically on January 1st for each year for a 12-month period unless terminated by either party upon 30 days notice in writing.
6. The licence fee, plus applicable taxes for the year, will be calculated in accordance with the terms of the tariff based on the information set out in the most recently filed report form or audit form, subject to adjustment to reflect any updated reports or audits pursuant to the tariff.
7. You will keep records of all information required to calculate the licence fees.
8. The licence fees and report (confirming that this licensee’s gross revenue from the events covered by this tariff during the year does not exceed \$15,422.88) are due no later than January 31st of the year covered by the licence or within ten days of any adjustments.
