

MUSIC LICENCE FORM - TARIFF 7 – SKATING RINKS (live or recorded music used in connection with roller or ice skating)

- Grants you permission to play (publicly perform) musical works using live or recorded music at your skating rink
- Annual fee is 1.2% of the annual gross receipts from admissions exclusive of any applicable taxes (where no admission is charged, the minimum fee is \$111.92 + taxes)
- Fee calculation is based on either the previous year's gross receipts or an estimate of the expected gross receipts from admissions (for the year covered by licence), if no music was performed in the previous year
- Deadline for SOCAN to receive forms and payments is no later than January 31st of the year for which a licence is granted, except for first time reports

The legal terms that govern your licence include those set out below as well as the terms found in the certified tariff including the General Provisions, as certified by the Copyright Board for each year (collectively, the “tariff”). 1. In this form, you, your and licensee means the person or company applying for a licence or filing a Music Licence Form. We, our, us and SOCAN means the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada. Works means any or all of the musical works in SOCAN's repertoire.
2. A copy of any tariff may be obtained from SOCAN by emailing licence@socan.com or calling 1.866.944.6223.
3. If the tariff for a year has not been certified by January 1st of that year, the last certified tariff will govern until the new version is certified, at which time adjustments will be made to reflect the certified tariff for the year.
4. This licence will automatically renew on January 1st unless terminated by either party upon 30 days' notice in writing.
5. The licence fee, plus applicable taxes, will be calculated in accordance with the terms of this licence based on the information set out in the most recently filed report form or audit form, subject to adjustment to reflect any updated reports or audits pursuant to the tariff.
6. You will keep records of all information required to calculate the licence fees.
7. No later than January 31st of the year for which this licence is issued, you will file with SOCAN a report estimating the gross receipts from admissions based on the actual total gross receipts from admissions from the previous year, and shall pay those estimated fees for the year for which the licence is issued.
8. Report forms of the actual gross receipts from admissions and payment of any adjustment of the licence fees are due January 31st of the year following the year for which the licence is issued or within 10 days of any adjustments.
