RECORDED MUSIC FOR DANCING

Quick Facts

Licence period:
one year (Jan. to Dec.)

Annual fee:
based on premises' capacity (rounded up to the nearest multiple of 20 when above 100) and days and months of operation (+ taxes)

Deadline:
Jan. 31st of the licensed year (music licence form and payment)

Music Licence Form:
socan.ca/form/18

Licence to play (publicly perform) recorded music for dancing in bars, clubs, cabarets, discotheques and other eating/drinking establishments

Licence fee calculation

Here is a simplified way to calculate the applicable fee rate: Take the room capacity rounded up to the nearest multiple of 20, subtract 100 and divide by 2. Use this number (as a percentage) to calculate your fee rate.

base rate table:

6 months or less		over 6 months	
<6 days	\$286.85	<6 days	\$573.69
4-7 days	\$573.69	4-7 days	\$1147.38

EXAMPLE:

Disco2000 has a capacity of 169 and is open 2 days a week over 12 months.

According to the table, the base rate is \$573.69

Fee: 169 rounded up to the nearest multiple of 20 is 180
 $(180 - 100) / 2 = 40 \rightarrow$ fee rate = 40%

$\$573.69 + 40\% = \803.17 .

Disco2000's licence for the year is \$803.17 + taxes

The tariff 18 matrix displays fees based on the days and months of operation, with no manual calculation needed. Check it out at socan.ca/18 (the matrix is included in the music licence form)
