Licence to play (publicly perform) music at receptions, conventions, assemblies, and fashion shows

Quick Facts

Licence period:

one quarter (Jan. to Mar.; Apr. to Jun.; Jul. to Sept.; Oct. to Dec.)

Per event* fee:

based on room capacity** and if there is dancing (see rate table)

Deadline:

within 30 days of the end of each quarter (music licence form and payment)

Licence fee calculation

Rate Table:

room capacity	fee per event	
	without dancing	with dancing
1–100	\$20.56	\$41.13
101–300	\$29.56	\$59.17
301–500	\$61.69	\$123.38
Over 500	\$87.40	\$174.79

EXAMPLE 1:

From Jan. to Mar., Roses Hall hosted 3 events:

Jan. 7 – 120 people – with dancing
Feb. 24 – 300 people – without dancing
Mar. 17 – 50 people – without dancing

The hall licence fee for the 1st quarter of 2010 is:
 $\$59.17 + \$29.56 + \$20.56 = \$109.29 + \text{taxes}$

EXAMPLE 2:

The Autumn Fashion Show was held on Sept. 10-11-12 with 250 people in attendance; however the room has a capacity of 450 people.

The licence fee for the fashion show is:
 $3 \times \$61.69 = \$185.07 + \text{taxes}$
